This committee will serve for 2 years, 2010 and 2011 and I'm sure you will extend your usual support and cooperation to them.

As many of you know, for a very long time, we have been trying to engage Glomac in a collaborative way to help improve the image of SBCR. Unfortunately, due to the many management changes in Glomac, our efforts have not been very successful.

Recently however, Glomac's current management has shown a positive reaction to our concerns and have taken some measures that we are thankful for. Thanks to the patient efforts of En Faizal, we have made some progress with Glomac in recent months in the following areas;

- a) On 11 to 14th June, repaired the leaking sewerage pipes contaminating the drain and lake in the park
- b) Cleared 25 unkempt lots owned by Glomac
- c) Removal of debris from drains and culverts which were breeding grounds for mosquitoes

- d) Treated the swimming pool in the showhouse along Jalan Seroja 1/1 with abate to prevent mosquito breeding
- e) Unblocked the drains in Jalan Seroja 1/1B which were leading to ponding of water for the past few months.
- f) Developed an initial plan to enhance security in Phase 1 and Phase 3 through the establishment of more guard houses and other security features. We hope this plan will be progressed further to improve the security here.

I would like to encourage you to highlight any concerns you have or give feedback so that we can continue to engage Glomac and seek practical solutions. Please feel free to reach out to any of our committee members if you have any issues.

One of the concerns we have is our small membership. It is my wish that every resident in SBCR becomes a member of SBCRHA so that we can collectively do more programs and activities to promote our friendship and interactions. On that point I would like to seek your support to encourage your neighbors and friends to become members of our association.

Celebrations are always an exciting thing and very soon our Muslim friends will be ushering in the puasa month. To begin the excitement, I am happy to wish all Selamat Berpuasa.
